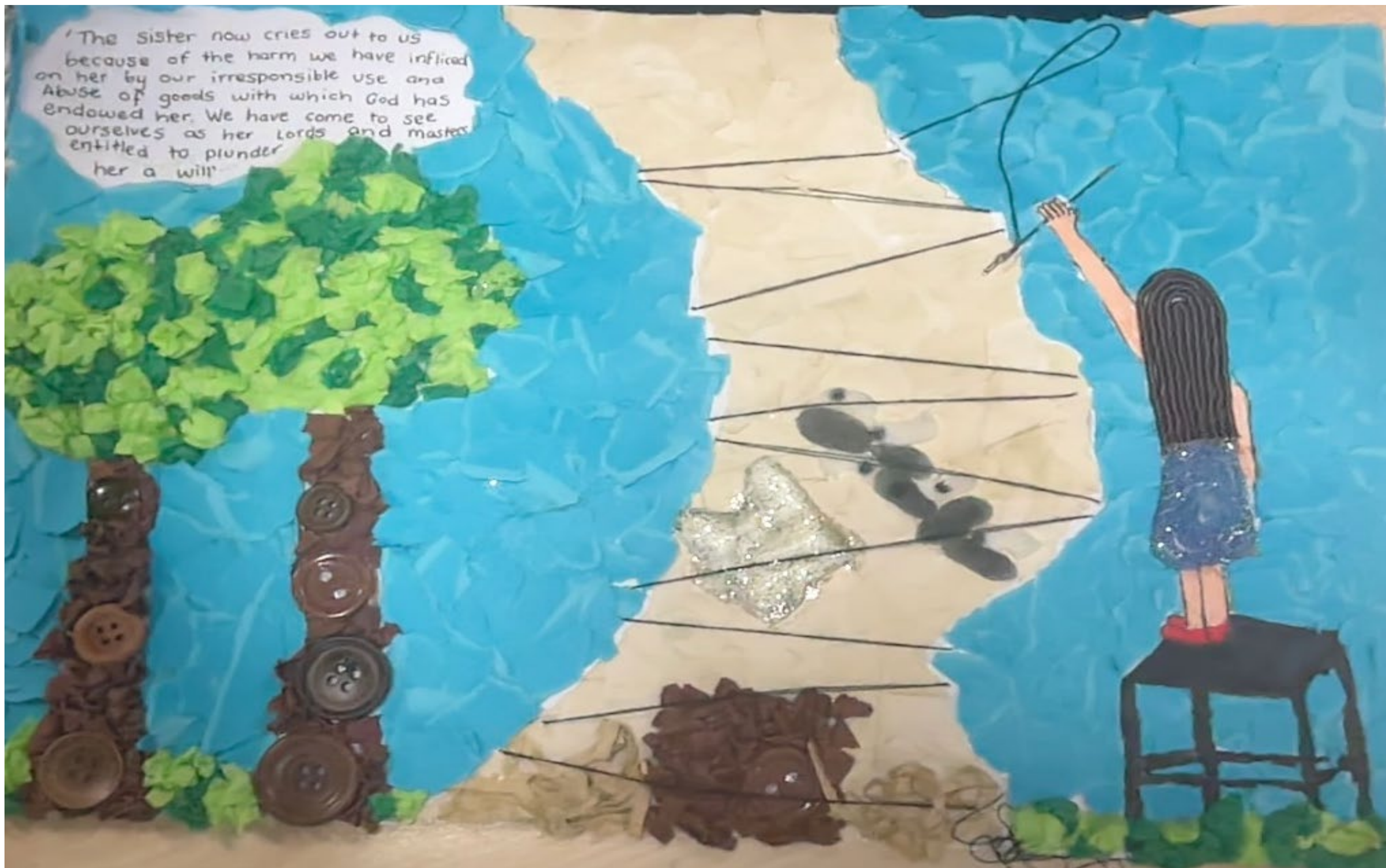


How can we practice being at peace with creation? ✨
