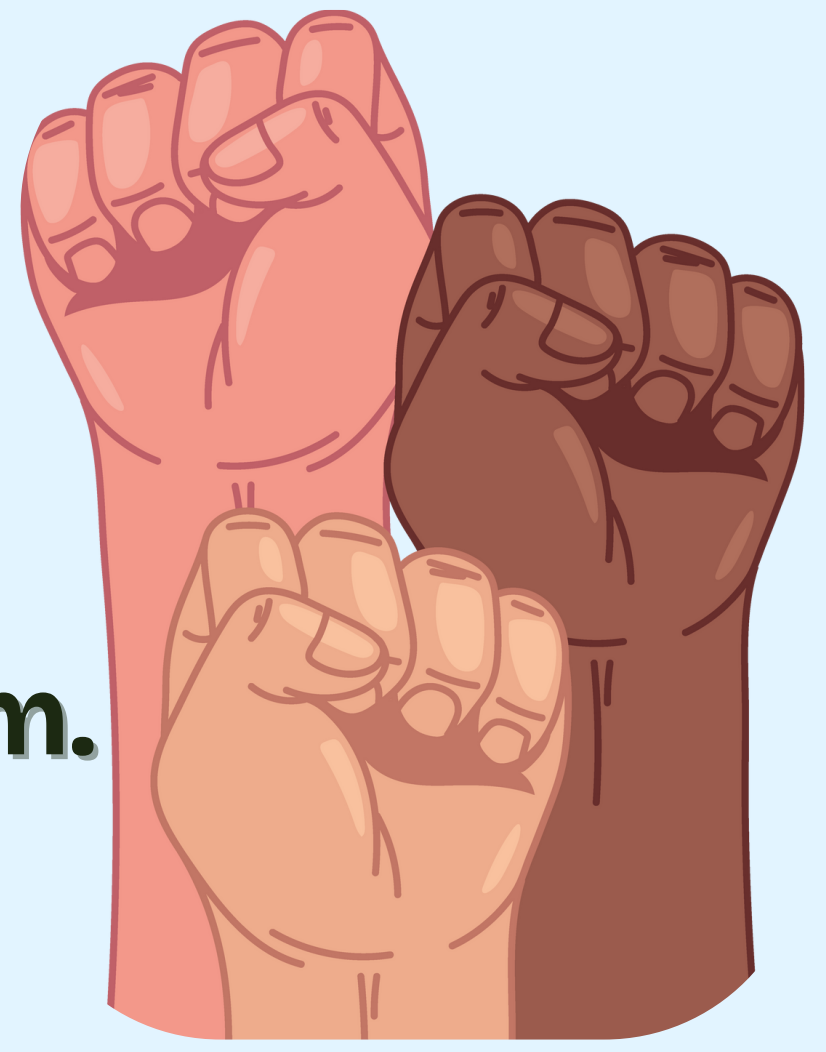


**Peace is walking outside
